I proposed to my fiancé in December 2013 and we set a date for our wedding on October 11, 2014. Several months later we decided to have our wedding ceremony and reception at the Sofitel in Philadelphia.

Among the many important decisions that we had to make we knew the importance of a DJ. Prior to selecting the Sofitel, we visited many places to select the location for our wedding and ceremony. Every place that we visited listed vendors that they recommend and have worked with in the past. All of the locations listed Silver Sound as a choice. I had no idea how well-known their company is in the Philadelphia area. This made us feel confident that Silver Sound was the right choice. I received several emails leading up to our wedding. The Silver Sound site enabled us to list songs that we wanted to be played. I found this to be very helpful. We were also able to list the members in the wedding party and the order in which they would be introduced. Again, very helpful as these are the types of important things that I would overlook and made the process much easier. The information that I imported into the site was also sent to Dan. He replied about the music and how excited he was to be apart of our wedding. His reply ensured me that he not only had the music, but that he was organized and we were important.

We continued to plan and got caught up in our day to day responsibilities. Dan reached out to me by phone and asked that we take the time to wrap up the fine details to make sure that all would turn out the way we wanted. I provided him with some information and he offered many beneficial suggestions without ever being pushy or demanding. Dan even allowed me to hear several tracks to make sure that they were the versions that we wanted as nowadays there is so much music available. Dan's assistance and experience were so valuable, especially at crunch time! He made me feel comfortable and confident that everything would go well and as planned.

Two days prior to the wedding I received a picture text from Dan. It was a picture of the outside of the Sofitel that he personally took. It made us even more excited about the wedding! He took the time to visit the hotel to see the location and speak with the staff about the reception and how to move his equipment into the facility. I found this to be extremely professional.

As I previously mentioned, we held the wedding ceremony and reception at the Sofitel. The Sofitel holds both in the same room (Paris Ballroom). Dan was ready to go prior to our ceremony without making any noise or distractions.

Following the ceremony, all of our guests moved into the Paris foyer. Dan played music during this time and I took the time to briefly chat with him.

Then, we lined up for the introductions into the reception. During one of our phone conversations, Dan took the time to spell the names phonetically to ensure that all names were pronounced correctly. He played all of the introductions perfectly according to our plan. The guests loved it! We (bride and groom) then began our first dance which was followed by father/daughter and mother/son dances. He mentioned that we could give him a heads up if we wanted any of the songs shortened. This was perfect because some of the songs were quite long and my mother did not want to be out on the dance floor for a long time as she was nervous! Eventually, we sat and began to eat. Dan played all of the songs that we requested. Also worth noting is that the site allows you to pick when songs are played. He did so at the appropriate time and the dance floor filled up quickly.

The speeches from the best man, maid of honor, and matron of honor took place and he made sure that everyone at the reception was able to clearly hear each word. His equipment was top of the line and he even brought an extra speaker to make sure the room was filled with great music, but not too much so the guests could still hold conversations.

Dan provided more current music as the night continued, but nothing that the guests felt was inappropriate and I was surprised to see the older generation still out on the dance floor. We actually never ate our cake due to the fact that we did not want to sit down.

I was approached by Dan towards the end of the reception. He asked if we would like to slow the party and the music down or to keep it going. This was very considerate and to which I replied, keep this party going and he surely did!

Eventually, I met back up with Dan as we were pulled away for a few thousand more pictures. I thanked him many times as did the guests.

The next day I received a text from him. He thanked us for selecting him to be apart of our big day and asked what we thought of the reception. Of course we loved it! He even sent us pictures!
